REASON FOR CHANGE

Need to have a clearer procedure, easier and understandable for all the ITCC members (Sponsor Institutions Committee, NCC, sites)

IMPLEMENTATION PLAN:

Following approval by the ITCC Sponsor Institutions Committee, the SOP will be disseminated to all ITCC sites.



PURPOSE:

The purpose of this SOP is to have a clear process to confirm the Sponsor for an academic-ITCC clinical trial and to select the NCCs and sites to run the trial.

SCOPE:

This SOP is applicable for the ITCC Sponsors, NCCs and the selected sites.

PROCEDURE

- 1) A Lead investigator proposes a trial.
- 2) This trial is presented to the CTC, which can add comment and suggest revisions before ITCC approval of the trial given.
- 3) The CTC allocates a number to the trial on behalf of the ITCC (ITCC-XXX) and notifies the Sponsor Institutions Committee
- 4) If Sponsor known, the Sponsor Institutions Committee sends a letter of approval to the sponsor. If Sponsor is not known, it will be proposed by the Sponsor Institutions Committee
- 5) The Sponsor sends an expression of interest to NCCs to notify them that there is an ongoing trial.
- 6) The Sponsor can now choose the National Co-ordinating Centres (NCC) to conduct the trial, among the 11+6 ITCC NCCs (11 additional NCCs and 6 single-site countries).
 - If the national site selected is not an ITCC NCC:
- Sponsor must request for an exception and justify its choice; ITCC NCCs have to explain why they can't conduct the trial; the selected center has to demonstrate expertise in acting as NCC.
- The Sponsor Institutions Committee, the Sponsor and the selected center may need to have an extraordinary TC to discuss the proposal.
- If the proposal is approved, the selected center is considered NCC for this trial ONLY.
 - If the proposal is not approved, the center is not accepted for the trial, further discussion and feedback is possible with the potential for subsequent approval as NCC
- 7) The selected NCCs can now suggest to the Sponsor the national ITCC sites to participate in the trial. NCCs and/or Sponsor can follow their own /national processes for site selection, for example by utilising a circulation of "Expression of Interest" on behalf of the Sponsor (sent from the ITCC secretariat).
- 8) The Sponsor agrees the final selection of suggested sites in agreement with the relevant NCC.
